



## Music Therapist Employment Application Instructions

### How to Apply

To apply for a position with NeuroRhythm, please email the following:

- Cover letter stating:
  - Why the applicant is interested in a position with NeuroRhythm
  - The applicant's music therapy philosophy and specializations
  - Be familiar with NeuroRhythm's "Vision and Mission" <http://neurohythm.com/about-us/vision-mission/> and "Why Choose NeuroRhythm" <http://neurohythm.com/about-us/why-choose-neurohythm/> website pages. Discuss your view of how you see your own philosophy and values aligning with NeuroRhythm's.
  - Professional goals
- Resume
- References: names, phone numbers and emails for 3 professional references with at least two being from clinical supervisors

### Interview

- If the applicant is called for an interview, there is a meeting/discussion portion of the interview as well as a musical/clinical audition. If possible, the applicant should interview in person and work with NeuroRhythm's clients. If an in person interview is not possible, it is conducted via live video chat.
- For the audition, please prepare 3 songs appropriate for children with neurodevelopmental challenges, and describe the goal for each song.
  - 1 song should be sung and accompanied on guitar
  - 1 song should be sung and accompanied on piano/keyboard
  - 1 song should be sung a capella
